### **BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE**

The building project is progressing well. The new learning space is taking shape and will be known as The Woods Learning Centre.











Fr Julian Tenison Woods had great public speaking skills and keen interests in geology, environmental management, and indigenous education. His journeys across the district heightened his interest in the geology of the region. Fr Julian Tenison Woods was the first scientist to chart much of the sub-terrain of the South East. His scientific genius, artistry in recording flora and excellent communication skills earned him a strong reputation for his expertise in this field. Father Woods' theories and opinions in the area of botany, geology, marine biology, geography and paleontology are widely respected, even today.

It is our responsibility at Mary MacKIllop Memorial School that we nurture students' values, character traits, skills, dispositions and knowledge after Fr Julian Tenison Woods and endeavor that they will be truly inspired by him while learning in The Woods Learning Centre.

### from the principal

Dear Parents and Friends,

As I walk around the classes I have been asking students five critical questions:

What are you learning? Why?

How are you doing in what you are learning?

How do you know?

How can you improve?

Where do you go for help?

These questions give insight into the effectiveness of explicit teaching and learning and assists students in being engaged in their own learning and how they are going with it. As a school we continue to seek ways to co-construct with students so that they experience agency of their learning.

### **LENT 2022**

Lent begins next week. It lasts for the 6 weeks before Easter and is a time when we practice being quiet and thoughtful. During this time, we pray, give money to charities and give up some things that we might otherwise do for pleasure. As a school community we commit to helping those less fortunate than ourselves. One way in which we do this is through Project Compassion. Project Compassion is Caritas Australia's annual Lenten fundraising and awareness-raising appeal which brings thousands of Australians together in solidarity with the world's poor to help end poverty, promote justice and uphold dignity. The theme this year is: For All Future Generations.

#### COVID UPDATE

#### Vaccination status of volunteers

From Week 5, volunteers approved by the Principal may return to the school (including in classrooms). To protect our staff and students, volunteers approved by the Principal to attend in person (including Board Members) must be vaccinated.

Noting that volunteers supplement and support the

work of our staff, the requirement for volunteers to be vaccinated arises from the Emergency Direction in relation to mandated vaccination of persons working in South Australian education and care settings.

Volunteer vaccination data will be recorded in the Data Collection at our site.

Parents who visit the school, who are not volunteering, need not provide evidence of their vaccination status. I ask that all parents volunteering ensure that they contact Janice and pass on their vaccination status.

#### ONE FORTY ONE GRANT OPEN ROUND

Stand Like Stone and OneFortyOne are continuing their partnership to support local community groups with their \$50,000 grants program. Applications opened on 15th of February, not for profit groups in the Limestone Coast region are encouraged to apply for a funding boost.

#### ADDITIONAL SCHOLARSHIP ROUND OPEN

#### LENT

Lent is a time that is super important in the cycle of the Church Year. It is the time in which Christians prepare themselves for the crucifixion and then the resurrection of Christ. Lent begins with Ash Wednesday and finishes after 40 days later (not including Sunday's). But what do people DO during Lent?

Because Lent is a preparation time for such an important event the Church gives us direction of what we can do to prepare. The three ways in which we can prepare is through fasting, alms giving and prayer. One of the reasons Christians fast during Lent is to be reminded of Jesus time in the desert prior to His public ministry as well as a way of remembering the sacrifices Jesus made for us. Alms giving is a reminder to help those less fortunate than us and Prayer is an act that can bring us all closer to God.
