Scholarships at Mary MacKillop Memorial School Information for Application form

Policy Statement

- 1. MMMS will award scholarships as a way of increasing access of enrolment to young people who would benefit from and contribute to Catholic education at MMMS.
- 2. Scholarships will be awarded to young people whose family may otherwise find it an increased burden to meet the cost of school fees.
- 3. Scholarships will be awarded on a range of criteria, which take into account the merit and need of eligible students.
- 4. In 2024 up to 2 scholarships will each be awarded for students enrolling or who are already enrolled at MMMS for up to 2 years, subject to meeting with the Principal.
- 5. Both full and partial scholarships will be awarded depending on meeting the criteria as stated below.

Criteria

Mary MacKillop Memorial fosters the expectation that each student will become the best person he or she can be. In making our decision we will consider the following criteria:

- 1. Full scholarships may be awarded to students who are eligible for 'School Card' (please refer below) in the year of application.
- 2. Part scholarships may be awarded for a period of two years to families whose circumstances may affect their access to a Catholic Education.
- 3. Satisfactory interview with the Principal.

What does the Scholarship Cover?

Full Scholarships: 100% of Tuition Fees

Part Scholarships: 50% of the Tuition Fees

Confidentiality

All information provided to the school will be kept on a strictly confidential basis and will be viewed and assessed by the Principal and Finance Officer only. We also respect the sensitivity of being successful with this scholarship and therefore there will be no formal public recognition of successful applicants.
